An Important Notice for Wyoming Medicaid Providers

Effective August 1, 2005 Wyoming Medicaid will be implementing a Mandatory Prior Authorization for Erectile Dysfunction medications. Those medications requiring Prior Authorization include: Caverject, Cialis, Edex, Levitra, Muse and Viagra.

The Prior Authorization Erectile Dysfunction Medication Request Form must be faxed to the Wyoming Department of Health's Pharmacy Services at **307-777-8623**. **This form is not to be faxed directly to ACS.** If the request is approved, a prior authorization will be given within 72 hours of the Pharmacy Services receiving the request. Both the prescriber and the pharmacy will be notified of the approval and the pharmacy will then be able to process the claim. If the request is denied, both the prescriber and the pharmacy will be notified either by fax or phone. The reason the coverage of an Erectile Dysfunction medication would be denied is that the Medicaid client is found to be listed on the Wyoming Registered Sex Offenders List.

Please note that the quantity limit still applies to the Erectile Dysfunction medications. Please refer to the EqualityCare Provider Manual.
